Check to see if there is information on the wishes of the person who has died	Tick List	Date
Contact solicitors/bank/accountants and the Principal Registry for the Family Division to check if there is a Will		
Speak to friends and family		
Check if the deceased has an informal list or formal Will at their residence		
I feel sure I have what I need now concerning their wishes		
I know I have legal authority to act on the deceased's behalf
